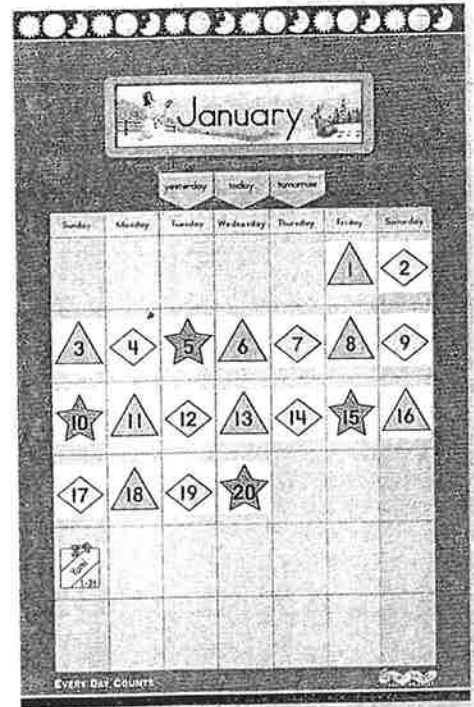

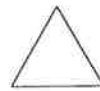

Word Study • Compound Words

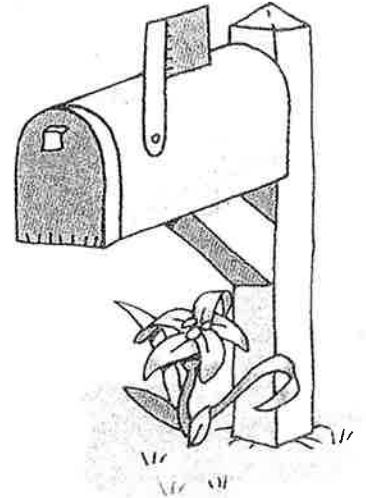
A **compound word** is made up of two smaller words. Sometimes, the smaller words can help you figure out the meaning of the compound word.
