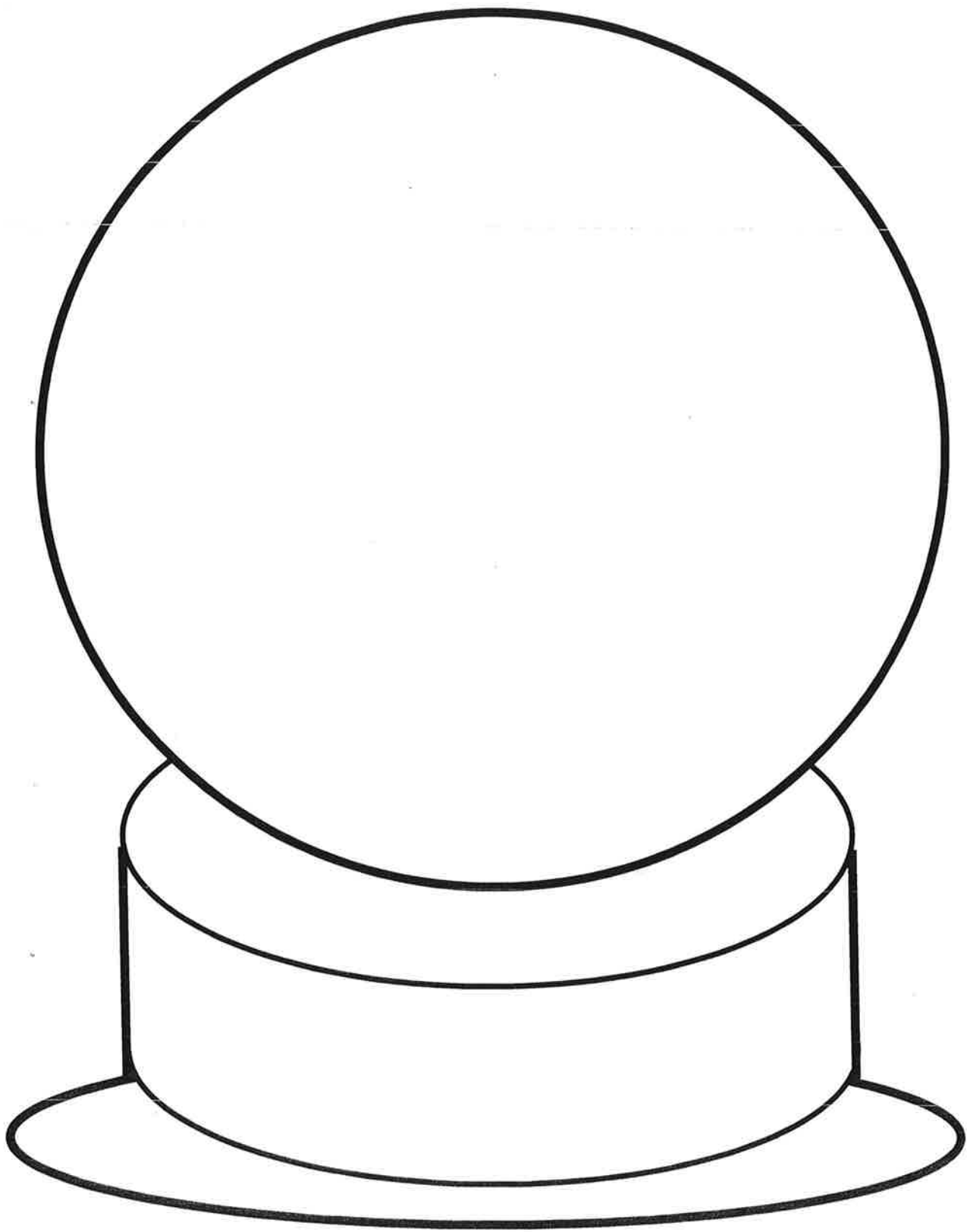

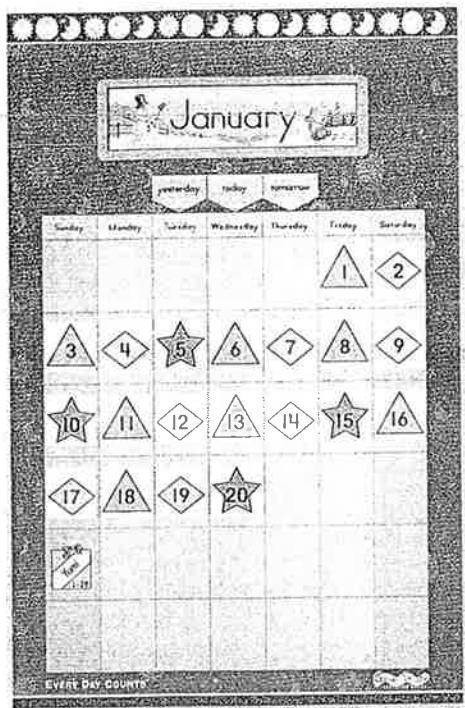

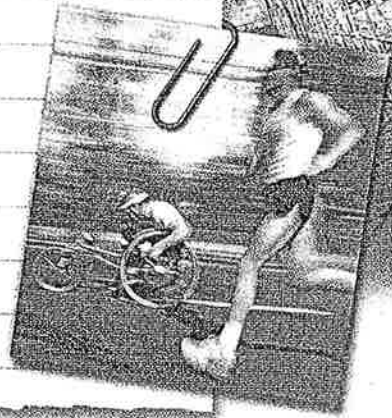
Read the journal entry. Then write a sentence to answer each question below.
