Singular and Plural Possessive Nouns

A noun that shows ownership is a possessive noun.

To turn a singular noun into a possessive noun, add an apostrophe (') and an - s,

example: The <u>boy's</u> wagon is in the garage.

To turn a *plural noun that ends in -s* into a **possessive noun** add an **apostrophe (')** after the -s.

example: The farmer painted horses' stables.

To turn a plural noun that does not end in -s into a possessive noun add an apostrophe (') and an -s.


example: The women's hats were beautiful.
